



## Ring Sizing Guide

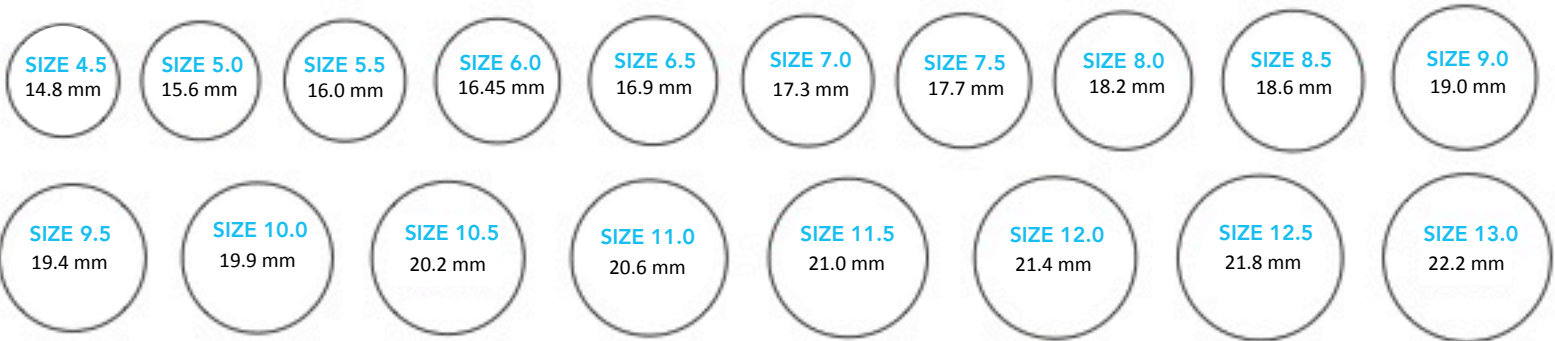
### Printing Instructions

Print this page. Be sure the printer is set to print at 100% which will ensure an accurate measurement. Verify the page printed correctly by measuring a few shapes with a ruler to ensure they are accurate.

### Tips and Information

- For the most accuracy, have someone help you measure
- Take multiple measurements to ensure an accurate reading
- All measurements match the inside diameter of the ring
- If your finger measurement falls between sizes, order the larger size
- Measure your fingers at the end of the day because fingers are smaller in the morning and bigger by the end of the day
- Weather and temperature affect finger size, so it's best to take measurements where it's moderately warm
- If you have large knuckles, measure both the base of your finger and your knuckle and select a size between the two
- Fingers are different on each hand, measure the finger on the hand that will adorn your ring

Place a ring that fits you over the closest matching sized circle, make sure the inside of the ring lines up with the outside of the circle. If you are between sizes, order a larger size.



### Method 2

**STEP 1** - Find a piece of non stretchy string

**STEP 2** - Wrap it snugly around the base of your finger, but not too tight

**STEP 3** - Mark the point on the string where it overlaps forming a complete circle

**STEP 4** - Compare the length of the string to the images below to determine your size
